**REPLY TO THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL'S MOTION TO
STRIKE HEARING SET FOR JUNE 16, (2017) AND REQUEST FOR
SCHEDULING ORDER**

Petitioner, Pro Se, Robin Mayes requests the District Court deny this motion to strike the hearing set for June 16th for the following reasons to wit:

1. The OAG appears to redirect the issue at bar toward technical concerns that if accommodated will further interfere with resolve of Petitioner's valid complaint regarding interference with the Election Commission and thereby negatively impact a free and fair election process. The OAG complains of Petitioner's naming of the CNO Office of the Attorney General. Petitioner has a well-established and continuing argument that the 1999 constitution revision that removed the "of Oklahoma" from the name remains unapproved by the United States of America as is the requirement. Petitioner prefers to keep to the stated issue regarding the Respondents' failure to provide due process in accordance with the 1999 constitution and the Election Law where interference with the Election Commission is concerned. The OAG assumes that Petitioner has made a mistake but it isn't a mistake. The OAG's failure to call out the correct date of the hearing is a mistake.
2. The OAG again complains of another technical obstacle to their directly addressing the issue raised by pointing to Petitioner's improper service of the original complaint. Petitioner is Pro Se and admits to limited understanding of Court rules and standard procedures. However, Petitioner does assert that he, in good faith and due diligence, delivered a true and complete copy to the both Respondents' offices to high ranking individuals that he had been in

communication with during the development stages of this case. Further, the very motion to strike includes admission that the OAG is fully aware of Petitioner's filing. Additionally, it should be noted that the Tahlequah Daily Press ran an article on the front page regarding the filing of the original petition, filed Thursday at 4:00 PM, in the Sunday edition. The Attorney General himself was interviewed and he gave a lengthy response.

Petitioner apologizes to the Court and the Respondents if failure to provide proper service was a disruption. Petitioner lives in Texas and wanted to provide Respondents with this information as quickly as possible as he recognizes the time constraints regarding this election and election schedule.

3. Lastly, Petitioner questions why, in the interest of free and fair elections, the OAG fails to address Petitioner's complaint regarding Respondents' refusal to grant due process according to the constitution and Election Law regarding interference with the Election Commission.


CONCLUSION


