ORDER

The Supreme Court of the Cherokee Nation hereby amends provisions to the Appendix: Supreme Court Procedures. The amended provisions are the following:

163. Election of Chief Justice

Rule 163. Election of Chief Justice


The Chief Justice of the Supreme Court shall be a Justice who has two (2) remaining years left in his or her term of office and who has served on the Court for two (2) years prior to his or her taking office as Chief Justice. In the event no Justice qualifies hereunder then the Justice that has four (4) remaining years left in his or her term of office shall serve as Chief Justice. The Chief Justice term of office shall expire upon the expiration of his or her term of office as Justice.

These Supreme Court Rules and Procedures are amended this 18th day of December, 2012.
