AFFIDAVIT OF NORMAN W. CROWE JR.

- 1) On December 11, 2017, Norman W. Crowe Jr. entered his name as a plaintiff in the above mentioned case.
- 2) On or about that time, Norman W. Crowe Jr. signed an affidavit stating that he had voted in the March 3, 2007 special election.
- 3) In his response of December 29, 2017, Attorney General Todd Hembree stated, "The Citizen's Motion should be dismissed with prejudice because five of eight of the listed Citizens committed perjury."
- 4) Norman Crowe is listed as one of the five of eight Citizens who had committed perjury.
- 5) Hembree further stated that Cherokee Nation Election Commission Voting Records showed that Norman W. Crowe did not vote in the election as stated in his affidavit.
- 4) Mr. Crowe comes to the Court stating that he did vote in the March 3, 2007 special election and that the Cherokee Nation Election Commission Voting Records are in error.
- 5) Mr. Crowe also states that he was a resident of Midwest City, Oklahoma and was employed at Tinker Air Force Base at the time of the election. Mr. Crowe distinctly remembers voting absentee and mailing his ballot.
- 6) Lesa Crowe, wife of Norman W. Crowe Jr., will also attest to Mr. Crowe's voting in the election and will testify to his involvement in the campaign at that time.
- 7) Mr. Crowe is a retired, decorated military serviceman (USMC/US Army) with 24 years of dedicated service to our country. He takes umbrage to the assertion that he has lied in this court case, or has committed perjury.
